Tue 6 Aug is the **feast of the Transfiguration of the Lord.**

Thu 8 Aug is the **memorial of St Dominic** (1170-1221), priest. He founded the Order of Preachers (Dominicans).

Fri 9 Aug is the **feast of St Teresa Benedicta of the Cross (Edith Stein)** (1891 – 1942), virgin and martyr, patroness of Europe.

Sat 10 Aug is the **feast of St Lawrence** (d. 258), deacon and martyr.

In today's Gospel Jesus states 'a person's life is not made secure by possessions' and in the second reading we hear "There is only Christ: he is everything and he is in everything." The Listening Process indicates that people are much busier and have far more options open at weekends than heretofore, e.g. "a busy life has made it difficult for everyone including myself. Too much going on in the world today" (p. 14 Diocesan Listening Report).
