**TUESDAY 9 AUGUST:** Feast of St Teresa Benedicta of the Cross (Edith Stein), a patron of Europe, who was martyred at Auschwitz on 9 August 1942.

**WEDNESDAY 10 AUGUST:** Feast of St Lawrence, deacon and martyr (died 258 AD)

**THURSDAY 11 AUGUST:** Memorial of St Clare (1193-1253). A native of Assisi, Italy, she founded the religious order named in her honour. She is the patron of television.
