**SAINT OF THE SLUMS: MOTHER TERESA OF KOLKATA** (formerly Calcutta) is now Saint Teresa. In his homily at her canonisation Mass last Sunday Pope Francis prayed, "May this tireless worker of mercy help us increasingly to understand that our only criterion for action is gratuitous love, free from every ideology and all obligations, offered freely to everyone without distinction of language, culture, race or religion." Mother Teresa loved to say, he recalled: 'Perhaps I don't speak their language, but I can smile.' Reflecting on this, he said: "Let us carry her smile in our hearts and give it to those whom we meet along our journey, especially those who suffer. In this way, we will open up opportunities of joy and hope for our many brothers and sisters who are discouraged and who stand in need of understanding and tenderness." Today, the Pontiff prayed, "I pass on this emblematic figure of womanhood and of consecrated life to the whole world of volunteers: may she be your model of holiness!" May this saint of our time be an inspiration to all who give generous service in our parish of Boherlahan and Dualla, and throughout the world.
