THE CONCLUSION OF THE JUBILEE OF MERCY will be celebrated on **Sunday 20 November** at the **Cathedral, Thurles**. All parishes of the archdiocese are invited to participate in a pilgrimage walk in Thurles, followed by concelebrated Mass.
