Sun (29 Jan) marks the beginning of Catholic Schools' Week 29 January – 3 February. Its theme is: Catholic Schools: Learning with Pope Francis to care for our Common Home. This year Catholic schools Week focuses on Pope Francis' encyclical *Laudato Sì* (Praise be to you) published in May 2016. The encyclical deals with many environmental issues and asks us all to make the necessary changes in our lives to protect the planet for future generations. It is our responsibility to care for the world and make it a better place for future generations.

Friday (3 February) is the **memorial of St Blaise**. The <u>Blessing of Throats will be administered before and after all Masses in the parish today</u>. The blessing of St Blaise is a sign of our faith in God's protection and love for us and for all who are sick.
