Flor Coffey (Boherlahan Dualla)

1921-2014



On Friday, April 25th 2014, the death took place of Flor Coffey, Ard Mhuire, Thurles. Flor, who hailed from Ballinree, Boherlahan, was a well-known club and county hurler in his younger years and was a member of the Boherlahan team which won the County Senior hurling title in 1941. His brothers, Jerry and John, were also members of that team. Four years later in 1945, both Flor and John were members of the Tipperary Senior squad which defeated Kilkenny in the All Ireland Final. Sadly, both brothers had to leave home and their native club in search of gainful employment where they continued to play. Flor did return later in the forties and won a second All Ireland medal on the team that won All Ireland honours in 1949. In the early fifties, he went to live in Thurles and continued to play with Sarsfields, winning a County Final with them in 1952. Flor was laid to rest on Monday, April 28th in St. Patricks Cemetery, Thurles after Requiem Mass in the Cathedral of the Assumption, Thurles. May he Rest in Peace.
