Tuesday 8 August:: **Memorial of St Dominic** (1170-1221), priest. Of Spanish origin, he was the founder of the Order of Preachers (also called Dominicans) who became especially dedicated to teaching and prayer.

Wednesday 9 August: Feast of St Teresa Benedicta of the Cross (Edith Stein), virgin and martyr, co-patron of Europe. She was martyred in the Nazi gas chamber at Auschwitz on 9 August 1942.

Thursday 10 August: Feast of St Lawrence (died 258), deacon and martyr.

Friday 11 August: **Memorial of St Clare** (1193-1253), virgin. She followed St Francis of Assisi in his life of poverty and founded the Poor Clares.
