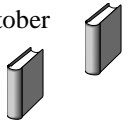
**NOVEMBER MASSES FOR THE DEAD:** For the Christian, death is the passage to full life in Christ. We pray for our loved ones that death for them brought them on a new journey into the fullness of eternal life. Our faith tells us that our prayers and masses can help all who have died whose faith is known to God alone. The November envelopes and lists for the dead will be distributed in the coming weeks. We ask you to fill up the lists and place them in the box available in the church. Thirty masses will be offered for our loved ones who have died. Prayers for the dead will be offered at Sunday Mass in both churches. The Parish Councils help in the distribution of the envelopes. There will also be spare envelopes available in porch of the churches
