**Pope Francis on Marriage and Family:**

*'It is a profound spiritual experience to contemplate our loved ones with the eyes of God and to see Christ in them. This demands a freedom and openness which enables us to appreciate their dignity. We can be fully present to others only by giving fully of ourselves and forgetting all else. Our loved ones merit our complete attention. Jesus is our model in this, for whenever people approached to speak with him, he would meet their gaze, directly and lovingly.'* (cf. Mk 10:21). (*Amoris Laetitia* 323)

**The Generosity of God:** *Faith reveals endlessly to me your "generous love," as [Cardinal] Newman calls it. This is shown dramatically in Jesus your Son. I can never get over the fact that he loved me and delivered himself over to death for me. Why ME? Yet there it is. I am loved, and I know it. Pope Francis's phrase sustains me: "when everything is said and done, we are infinitely loved"! Even when I miss the point of the Gospels, and fail to make life better for the miserable, your love remains generous and you give me endless opportunities to do good.* (Brian Grogan SJ).
