**Thu 22 Nov:** Memorial of **St Cecilia**, virgin and martyr. She is honoured as the patroness of music and musicians.

**Fri 23 Nov:** **Memorial of St Columban** (d. 615), abbot and missionary. He was a founder of important monasteries, especially Bobbio in Italy. He is remembered as one of the greatest Irish missionaries.

**Sat 24 Nov:** **Memorial of Ss Andrew Dũng-Lạc**, priest and **Companions**, martyrs. They are venerated especially in Vietnam.
