A Holiday of the Spirit: *'Amid the stresses of Jesus' conflict with the enemies of the Kingdom, he derived power to go on from frequent protracted periods of prayer, in which he renewed his rest in the Father's love, and he was helped by two human sources of joy, his love of little children and his pleasure in flowers...
