Arising from the Listening Process that has been conducted in the Diocese during the last year, a number of priorities have been recommended. One of these is to have as much participation as possible of the congregation in the Liturgy of the Mass. Many good suggestions came up at our meeting. One that we felt we could start with very soon was the bringing up of the Offertory Gifts at the weekend masses. This has started and we are very grateful to those who have volunteered.

The next meeting of the Parish Pastoral Leadership Committee will be on Tuesday 22 October at 7.30pm in Boherlahan Parish Hall.

Mission Sunday : This weekend we celebrate World Mission Sunday. This is a day when our entire Church family comes together for a truly incredible celebration of solidarity. Today every single Church around the world shares what they can, so that the vital work of the Church and our missionaries can continue. Through your extra generosity you are offering much needed financial help to missionaries who dedicate their lives to those who are suffering and neglected. This collection will be taken up at all masses this weekend.

Visitation of the Sick: Hospitals and nursing homes are no longer permitted to provide priests with a list of parishioners who are their patients or residents. This is due to the new law called General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR). If you have a family member in a hospital or nursing home who would like a visit from a priest, please contact either priest of the parish (see telephone numbers at the top of the newsletter).

Safeguarding: We are asked to highlight during this month of October the work of Safeguarding that is ongoing in our Diocese. The Archdiocese ensures that all children involved in parish activities are safe and cared for. We have in place ; parental/guardian consent forms for all activities, code of conduct for both children and adults, sign in and out registers, Gardaí vetting for all adult helpers /leaders every 5 years.
