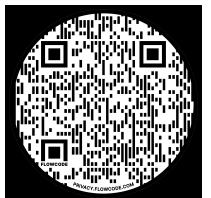

- This modern, multipurpose building will provide fantastic facilities for all to use for years to come.
- The plans include a large multi-usage hall, with adjoining performance stage, kitchen and fully serviced meeting and multifunction rooms on two levels.
- The Hall will also be directly accessible by St Isadore's N.S.
- The Community Centre plans were developed following consultation with local community groups and from returned surveys.

Car Park Proposal

- Separate vehicle and pedestrian access to car park for safety.
- “Town and Village Renewal Scheme” – Tipperary County Council will provide pathways linking the carpark to the Community Centre, Church and GAA field.
- Increases parking capacity in the village by 17 spaces to satisfy planning requirements.
- Suitable fencing and public lighting provided in car park for safety.
- There is no change or impact to the existing pond or drainage network.
